BUCKINGHAM'S APOLLO 3 ALREADY A SUCCESS

The Buckingham based third Apollo office development can already be heralded a success. After only beginning construction on the site on the 23 April 2007 only 14 of the 20 office suites remain available to purchase.

Apollo 3 offers office suites from less than 1,000 sq ft to purchase or let. If required the suites can be combined to create larger office space. Joint agents Berry Morris, Lambert Smith Hampton and Meeson Williams are marketing the suites on behalf of Apollo Business Park. Completion of the development is anticipated in November 2007.

Apollo 3 follows on from the highly successful Apollo 2 in Banbury, where all but one of the office units were either sold or under offer at practical completion, Apollo 3 has taken the office campus concept one stage further.

Designed by Alan Drury Architects of Abingdon, the concept is two separate two-storey buildings built around a central open Japanese-style courtyard with a network of first floor walkways accessing the first floor offices and linked by a communal lift.

The Apollo brand has a clearly defined identity which stems from Robert Synge's background in motorsport. Robert ran his own motorsport team (Madgwick Motorsport), with many championship and race successes in Formula 3 and Formula 3000.

Commenting on the development, Robert Synge's said, "We try to be very flexible in our approach to property development; producing a basic specification which can be added to in order to perfectly suit the customer's requirements. In this way, our customers only pay for what they need. I prefer to work closely with my customers from the start to understand both their business and their requirements."
