



Apollo 3 prepares for launch

BUCKINGHAM'S strong local economy has persuaded a business park developer to build its third complex in the town.

Apollo 3 (pictured left) will be a campus of offices from less than 1,000 sq ft comprising two separate two-storey buildings built around an open Japanese-style courtyard.

It is sited on 1.2 acres that once

was a RAF storage depot in the Second World War.

Apollo Business Parks managing director Robert Synge said: "This is a very exciting design focused on creating a business community. We saw a gap in the market in this area which the Apollo brand would ideally fill."

"There is a strong local economy

around Buckingham with a large proportion of small knowledge-based companies but a distinct shortage of good quality, modern business units, resulting in out-migration to work.
