Work to start on new offices

CONSTRUCTION is due to start in May on new offices near Gawcott.

Apollo Office Court, in Radcliffe Road, will have two office blocks housing 20 units, which will measure around 1,000 sqft each, built around a central courtyard area.

The offices will have communal facilities including a kitchen, a small lounge/conference room and a variety of vending machines.

by Radcliffe-based company Apollo Developments Ltd, is expected to be finished by the end of the year.

Four of the 20 units have already been sold to outside companies, with another four to be retained by Apollo, three for renting and one to act as an office for the company.

Robert Syngle, managing director

of Apollo Developments Ltd, said the type of businesses expected to move into the new building included chartered surveyors, solicitors, graphic designers and software designers.

The land used to be a former RAF storage site during World War Two and was also a storage yard up until 1980.

It remained unused until Mr Syngle bought the site in 2000.
